If a candidate or Member of Parliament has not appointed a responsible person (agent), and is not endorsed by a registered political party, then they are their own agent.

If a group in a Council election has not appointed a responsible person (agent), and is not endorsed by a registered political party, then the first person whose name is to appear first in the group is the agent.
