Foreword

I am pleased to present the 2025 Local Government Ordinary Elections Statewide Report, which provides an overview of the Western Australian Electoral Commission (WAEC) operational activity and summary of the Results from elections held on 18 October 2025.



Of the 139 Local Governments in Western Australia, the WAEC was requested to conduct 127 elections, and implemented several process and reporting updates including:

- introduction of real-time provisional results reporting,
- streamlined count process through refined planning and resource allocation, and
- supported candidate nomination and elector participation through a partnership approach with local governments, Western Australian Local Government Association (WALGA), and Department of Local Government, Industry Regulations and Safety (LGIRS).

Election service delivery performance was assessed both internally and through the post-election survey to Local Governments and election workforce, with feedback applied for continuous improvement to future operations.

I extend my sincere thanks to the WAEC staff, Returning Officers, the temporary election workforce and the many stakeholders whose professionalism and commitment supported a high standard of transparency and compliance throughout this electoral process.

Together, we delivered a successful election. I look forward to building on this momentum to further strengthen our election delivery in the future.

Overview

About this Report

This 2025 Local Government Ordinary Election Statewide Report outlines WAEC service activities and summary of the Results from elections held on 18 October 2025 using data from the EMSWA* database, and Local Governments.

Of the total 139 Local Governments in Western Australia, 10 held in-person elections not conducted by WAEC, two did not go to election, and the remaining 127 requested WAEC conduct postal (119), and in-person elections (8). Eighty-five postal elections proceeded (from 119), and six of the eight in-person elections proceeded.

All Local Governments located in the metropolitan area and major regional locations adopted postal voting.

The WAEC's involvement in postal elections has increased at successive Local Government elections, with 2025 the highest to date. Local Governments participating in 2025 postal elections are listed at Appendix 1.

The WAEC conducted in-person elections for the Shires of Broome, Christmas Island, Derby-West Kimberley, Halls Creek, Menzies, and Waroona, with the Shires of Cocos (Keeling) Islands and Leonora elected unopposed and therefore not proceeding to election (*refer Appendices 1, 10*).

* EMSWA is an Election Management System used for WA Local Government elections. This system holds all information regarding local government elections, including details for: Local Government districts, candidates, resources, Returning Officer details, polling place details, electors and first preference election results.

Returning Officers use the LG Portal to access the EMSWA LG functions related to their assigned LG district.

Key election activities (events) reported

Across these Local Governments, WAEC conducted 221 separate election processes. This is due to some Local Governments electing multiple positions i.e. Mayors/Presidents plus individual Councillors.

This Report covers the key election activities in the following sections:

About Local Government Ordinary Elections

The *Local Government Act 1995* allows Councils to conduct their own elections as in-person ballots, but only the Electoral Commissioner may conduct a postal election.

Local Governments may opt for postal voting or in-person voting, depending on community needs and preferences. If a postal election is requested, the WAEC manages the end-to-end process, including the production, distribution and return of voting packages. For in-person elections, Local Governments may choose that WAEC conduct the election on their behalf.

Local Government Ordinary Elections are held every two years for Councillors and every four years for Mayors or Presidents, on the third Saturday in October. Directly elected Councillors and Mayors or Presidents are elected for four-year terms. Half of the Councillors retire from each district or ward every two years. Voting in Local Government elections is not compulsory in Western Australia.

Cost estimates

Under the *Local Government Act 1995* the WAEC conducts Local Government elections on accrual cost recovery basis.

WAEC provided Local Government CEOs with an indicative cost per elector for budgeting purposes only. Estimates are based on approximate candidate numbers, elector numbers, the mailing delivery service, staffing requirements and the predicted number of returned votes, based on previous elections.

At the 2025 Local Government postal elections, the average cost per elector was \$5.59 (\$5.17 in 2023).*

Election costs increased due to inflation, including higher salaries, printing, and postal and distribution costs.

Working in partnership

WAEC key activities were supported through constructive working relationships with stakeholders and service providers who had responsibility for aspects of election delivery including:

- **Local Governments:** managed owners and occupiers rolls in line with legislative requirements; provided logistical support (including securing polling locations, issuing replacement election packages and supporting election-day operations); and issued localised specific elector communications and engagement.
- **Department of Local Government, Industry Regulation and Safety (LGIRS):** provided regulatory oversight; and supported compliance with statutory obligations, including Local Government reporting requirements and governance standards.
- **Western Australian Local Government Association (WALGA):** provided policy guidance and resources to support Local Governments to meet legislative and best-practice standards.



- **Australian Electoral Commission (AEC):** shared expertise and resources to strengthen operational capacity and support continuity for critical election functions.
- **State Solicitor's Office (SSO):** provided legal advice on complex electoral matters.

As in previous Elections, Australia Post managed delivery of postal voting packages to electors.

* This cost is for the October 2025 Local Government Ordinary Elections only. Total FY costs for all local government elections combined (Ordinary and Extraordinary) per elector are reported in the associated WAEC Annual Report and Budget Papers.



Workforce recruitment and training

The 2025 Local Government elections core WAEC workforce were based at the head office, Processing Centre, and the ICT Build Centre. They were supported by Returning Officers (ROs), Returning Officer Liaison Officers (ROLOs), and temporary election workforce (TEW) who were located across election venues.

Returning Officers and election staff

In 2025, ROs remained the primary contact for candidates, Local Governments and electors in each Local Government area, supported by the ROLO. Recruitment prioritised experienced local staff to meet community needs.

Training for ROs and election staff was streamlined into role-specific sessions, with additional RO training for manual and full data-entry ballot counts. New videos explained optional preferential voting for single-vacancy elections (i.e. one position, such as Mayor, President or a single councillor seat) and multiple-vacancy elections.

Operational efficiency for election-day staffing processes was improved by adopting workforce feedback from previous elections resulting in better resource allocation.

Temporary election workforce

WAEC used a temporary election workforce (TEW) to staff the Local Government elections.

In total, 873 staff were deployed across 36 Local Governments, supporting polling, the central vote Processing Centre and WAEC election operations.

All TEW staff were trained by the WAEC and provided with instruction manuals, and mandatory reading of the Ballot Paper Handling Policy before commencing duties. The updated practical training included improvements identified from previous elections and participant feedback.

Nominations and candidates

Nominations opened on Thursday 28 August 2025 and closed at 4:00pm on Thursday 4 September 2025 (*refer page 6*). In accordance with legislation, Returning Officers accepted submissions only during this period.

Each nomination required a completed nomination form, candidate profile, optional written statement and photograph, a \$100 deposit, and completion of the mandatory LGIRS online induction. Candidates had to be registered electors for the district they sought to represent. Separate forms and fees applied to candidates nominating for both Mayor/President and Councillor positions.

Before nominations opened, WAEC, WALGA and LGIRS jointly hosted a candidate information webinar outlining candidate obligations and the election process.

Candidate numbers and trends

By the close of nominations, a total of 1,068 candidates had nominated across the 127 elections. Fifty-three candidates nominated across 15 Mayor/President vacancies, and 1,015 candidates nominated across 538 councillor vacancies.

High numbers of candidates were recorded in several districts, including the City of Albany with the most nominations with 23 candidates contesting four vacancies. Other Local Governments with high candidate numbers included the City of Gosnells with 22 candidates, the City of Busselton with 19 candidates, and the Shire of Derby–West Kimberley with 18 candidates.

Gender and age of candidates

The breakdown of candidates nominating for Local Government elections in 2025 was similar to 2023. In 2025, of the 1068 candidates, 634 (59.4%) candidates identified as male, 432 (40.4%) candidates as female, and 2 (0.187%) did not specify a gender.

In 2023, of the 1089 candidates who nominated for a council vacancy, 655 candidates identified as male (60.1%), 431 (39.5%) candidates as female and 3 did not specify a gender.

The ages of candidates in 2025 ranged from 18 to 87 years with an average age of 52. This is slightly lower than the average age of 53 in 2023.

Nomination builder

The online candidate application platform is Nomination Builder. In 2025, it was used by 92.1 percent of candidates to enter their details and complete a candidate profile.

Uncontested and unopposed elections

Of the 221 possible elections, 167 were contested and 54 were uncontested.

In uncontested elections, candidates are elected unopposed because the number of nominations received was equal to or fewer than the number of vacancies.

For postal elections, 135 candidates were elected unopposed, while eight candidates were elected unopposed for in-person elections.

Election delivery



Electoral rolls

The electoral rolls closed at 5.00pm on Friday 22 August 2025. The WAEC prepared residents rolls for the 137 Western Australian Local Governments scheduled to hold elections, including for those not utilising WAEC services.

Across the State, a total of 1,870,309 electors were enrolled on the residents' rolls. The WAEC produces the residents rolls for all Local Governments on the mainland of Western Australia, while the residents roll for the Commonwealth Territories of Christmas and Cocos/Keeling Islands are provided by the Australian Electoral Commission via the Northern Territory Electoral Commission.

The compilation of the owners and occupiers roll is the responsibility of the respective Local Government Chief Executive Officer, and these are provided to WAEC where it is prepared for upload to EMSWA (*refer footnote page 4*). This then forms the voting entitlement list which is passed onto the mailhouse when preparing the postal voting packages.

Candidates were permitted to obtain a copy of the roll for the area they were contesting once nominations were accepted. These rolls could only be used for election-related purposes. Unsuccessful candidates are required to destroy any copies of the roll after the election.

Check your enrolment portal

The "Check your enrolment" portal on the WAEC website was available for electors to check their details, and recorded 13,845 enrolment checks over the election period between 7 August and 18 October 2025.

Postal voting

Postal voting remained the preferred method for most metropolitan and major regional Local Governments, and in 2025 the WAEC conducted 119 postal elections, surpassing the previous high of 115 in 2023 (*refer Table 1*).

Election packages were lodged with Australia Post over an eight-day period, from 12–19 September 2025.

Remote Local Governments postal voting packages were prioritised and lodged to Australia Post on 12 September 2025, with mailout commencing that day.

Metropolitan Local Governments packages were lodged to Australia Post between 17–19 September 2025, with mailout commencing 17 September.

The WAEC Processing Centre operated as the hub for postal vote management. TEW staff operated in structured teams across five key stages of the processing workflow:

- 1) **Receivals** – Mail was received and election packages removed from reply-paid envelopes, with batch headers attached.
- 2) **Scanning** – Electors were marked off the electoral roll.
- 3) **Declaration/Ballot Paper Removal** – Declarations and ballot papers were separated and batched.
- 4) **Reconciliation** – Ballot papers were reconciled against batch headers and placed in sealed ballot boxes.
- 5) **Dispatch** – Sealed ballot boxes were returned to Local Governments for counting on election night.

The Processing Centre started receiving Australia Post daily mail deliveries from Tuesday 30 September 2025.

Election delivery

Over 15 days, 477,648 total election packages were received with 58.17 percent of all mail arriving by Thursday 2 October. Over three quarters of returned packages had been received (78.60 percent) by Wednesday 8 October and volumes decreased steadily from Thursday 16 October, ending at a daily total of 6,424 on Election Day (Saturday 18 October).

Postal vote receipts

A total of 515,999 returned election packages were scanned, consisting of 477,648 (92.56 percent) received via Australia Post and 38,351 (7.44 percent) received directly by Local Governments. This reflects a slight increase in packages received by Local Governments compared to 2023, where of 544,895 total packages scanned, 507,696 (93.17 percent) arrived via Australia Post and 37,199 (6.82 percent) via Local Governments.

Election package dispatch

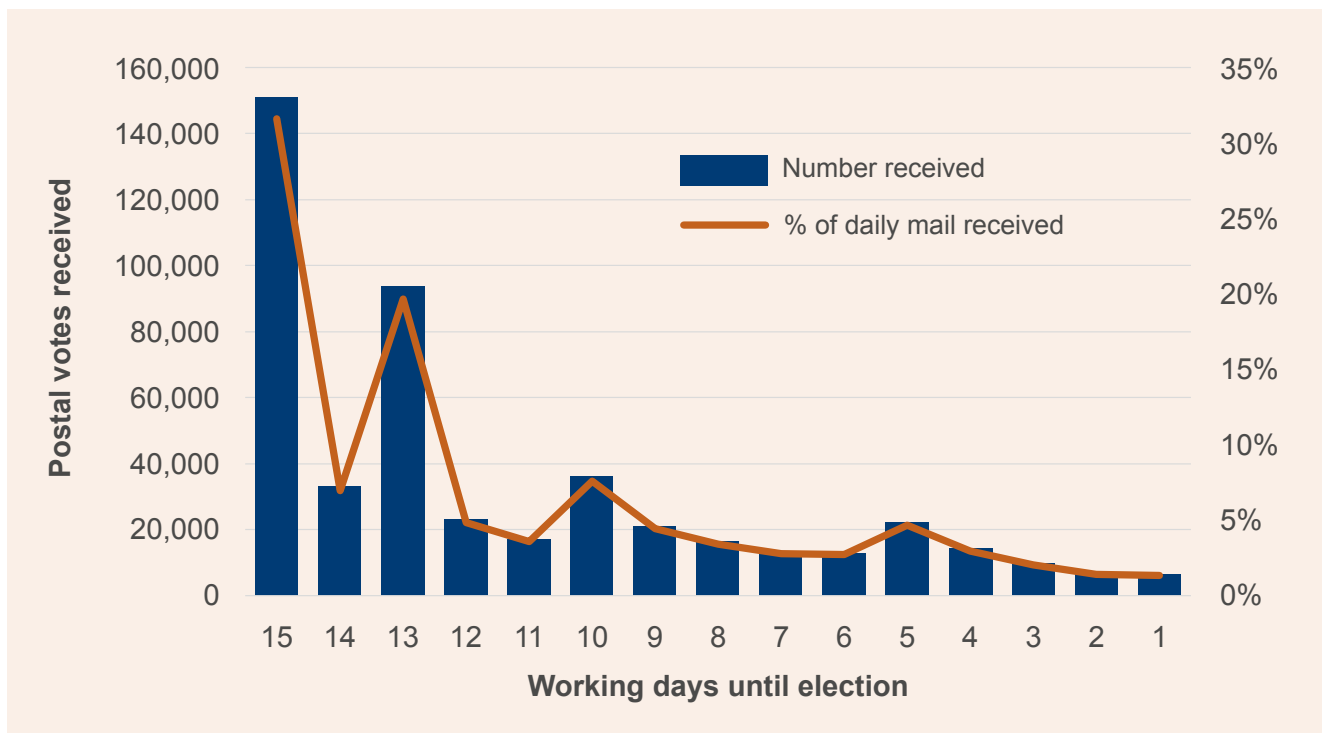
Of the 85 Local Government districts that proceeded to contested postal elections, 1,736,004 election packages were dispatched to electors (note the remaining balance of 34 Local Governments did not proceed to election after close of nominations, and so did not require postal voting packages).

All election packages were lodged with Australia Post at least four weeks prior to election day providing electors with around three and a half weeks to return their ballot material or longer depending on their location.

Rejected packages

Election packages were processed in accordance with legislative requirements where reasons for rejecting an election package were recorded (i.e. unsigned declaration, missing declaration or other).

Election delivery

Out of 515,999 returned packages, 9,744 were rejected representing 1.89 percent of all issued packages. This is less than the 2023 Local Government elections, where 12,358 packages were rejected, accounting for 2.1 percent of the total.

Refer Appendix 6 – reason for rejection of voter packages, also notes which elections were uncontested and therefore did not receive voter postal packages.

Replacement and provisional packages

Electors who misplaced or did not receive their ballot material could arrange for cancellation and re-issue of their ballot packages through their Local Government. During the 2025 Local Government Ordinary elections, 5,126 replacement packages were issued with 52 percent of replacements issued on Election Day. There was a total of 64 provisional votes issued.

By comparison, the 2023 Local Government elections recorded 5,851 replacements and 86 provisional votes, with 55 percent of replacements issued on Election Day.

In-person voting

The WAEC conducted in-person elections across six Local Governments in the Shires of Broome, Christmas Island, Derby-West Kimberley, Halls Creek, Menzies and Waroona.

To support accessibility and voter engagement, the WAEC also facilitated early voting across 27 designated locations within the six districts including Indigenous communities.

Voter participation

The overall participation rate for **postal elections** in 2025 was 29.7 percent, a decrease from 31.6 percent in 2023.

Four Local Governments adopted postal voting for the first time in the Shires of Carnamah, Cranbrook, Narembeen and Pingelly.

Among Local Governments where elections were contested in both 2023 and 2025, four recorded an increase in participation of more than 5 percent. *Refer Table 2 below.*

Voter participation metropolitan and country areas

For 2025 a total of 515,999 postal votes were received, with 383,002 (74.2 percent) postal votes from metropolitan area and 132,997 (25.8 percent) from country areas.

The average postal voter participation rate for metropolitan was 28.7 percent and for country areas was 33.0 percent.

The highest metropolitan voter participation rate was City of Fremantle at 39.8 percent (up from 36.3 percent in 2023), the lowest was City of Wanneroo at 25.4 percent (down from 26.9 percent in 2023).

Statistically, the highest country voter participation rate was Shire of Sandstone at 92.7 percent (with 51 of 55 enrolled voters participating), the lowest was Shire of East Pilbara at 22.2 percent.

In-person elections were conducted across six regional Local Governments, with a combined enrolment of 20,244 electors and 3,473 votes cast, resulting in an overall participation rate of 17.2 percent. Participation varied significantly by district with the highest participation in the Shire of Christmas Island at 59.5 percent and lowest participation in Shire of Broome at 11.3 percent.

Voter participation age range

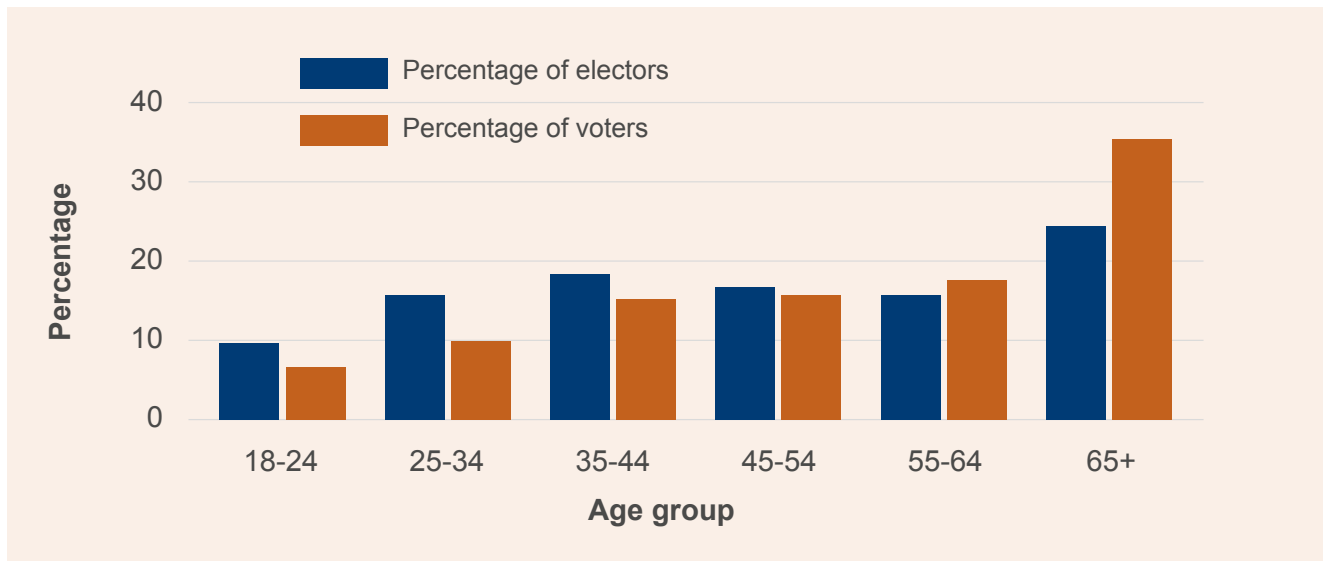
For postal elections, electors aged 18 to 24 accounted for 9.6 percent of the roll and represented 6.6 percent of voters, while those aged 25 to 34 made up 15.6 percent of electors and contributed 9.9 percent of votes. Combined, these cohorts represent over 25 percent of the enrolled population but less than 17 percent of total votes cast.

In contrast, electors aged 65 and over demonstrated the highest participation, comprising 24.3 percent of electors and representing 35.3 percent of votes.

Overall, younger cohorts under 35 are significantly underrepresented in voting, while electors 65 and older demonstrate the highest turnout.

Elector Services

Call Centre

A Call Centre was available during the Election period receiving 1,171 election related calls and 420 enrolment inquiries including 178 calls received on Election day. The majority of calls related to replacement packages, voting or returning packages, and asking if Local Government election voting was compulsory.

Complaints

Over the 2025 Local Government election period, 359 complaints were received.

Issues raised include misleading material, authorisation, social media activity, electoral rolls, signage, candidates and WAEC conduct. Matters were dealt with in accordance with the Act, associated regulations and Commission policy (*Refer Table 5*).

The majority were responded to on the day.

The WAEC experienced technical issues with postage package pre-sealing, over printing and a low number of incorrect ballot papers, and as a result established a dedicated helpline which received 197 calls from impacted electors.



Communication and engagement

Election notices

In accordance with the *Local Government Act 1995*, four statutory notices were published on the WAEC website. These notices were also provided to Local Governments to publish on their respective websites, notice boards, social media and/or other channels. Each notice aligned with key election milestones including:

- **Notice 1:** 4 August – Close of enrolment: advised date of election and date by which an elector is required to be enrolled to be eligible to vote.
- **Notice 2:** 18 August – Call for nominations: listed vacancies, nomination period and procedure for submitting nominations.
- **Notice 3:** 19 September – Election Notice: election date, vacancies and all nominated candidates.
- **Notice 4:** 20 October – Declaration of results: declared the result of the election accompanied by the Calculated Steps Report detailing the distribution of preference votes.

Postal voting information brochure

The postal voting information brochure sent to electors was updated to include a step-by-step 'how to vote' process explaining the instructions for optional preferential voting. Language translations were updated based on Australian Bureau of Statistics data and guidance from the Office of Multicultural Interests.

Educational videos

To improve understanding of election processes, the WAEC produced instructional videos tailored for different stakeholder groups.

Available on the website, one key initiative was the [Your postal vote journey – inside the WAEC Processing Centre](#) video which provided community, stakeholders and candidates with an overview of the secure handling process for postal votes. This video aimed to build understanding of the integrity of the postal voting system.

In response to candidate feedback, the WAEC developed instructional videos to improve candidate understanding of the voting system available on the elections.wa.gov.au website. These included guidance on candidate eligibility, the nomination process (including Nomination Builder online app), postal voting for in-person and postal elections, and information about election day and the count.

Three internal practical training videos were developed for issuing absent votes, issuing provisional votes, and issuing replacement votes to support Local Government staff.

Local Government engagement

The WAEC commenced early engagement with Local Government stakeholders through weekly Electronic Direct Mail (EDM) newsletters providing updates on key activities and deadlines. This supported regular contact with governance managers.

Media management

Media management comprised of proactive and reactive engagement across multiple channels to highlight key electoral milestones and address emerging issues.

Five official media releases were issued at key stages of the election cycle, including the opening and closing of nominations, commencement of postal voting, advice to postal voters and declaration of results. These communications provided clear, accurate information to support community understanding and reduce misinformation.

The Electoral Commissioner conducted 11 interviews with statewide, local and regional broadcast outlets, about election processes, voting instructions, participation trends and operational improvements. The WAEC also hosted a media briefing at the Processing Centre prior to election day.

Reactive media coverage primarily focused on voting procedures, nomination requirements, voter participation, and election results.

Social media

A scheduled series of 21 social media posts were published across Facebook, Instagram and LinkedIn to promote election engagement and share key information.

Engagement metrics and community feedback were monitored throughout the election period to assess audience reach and user comments.

Social media was also used proactively to correct misinformation and provide credible updates.



The WAEC also supported the WALGA and LGIRS social media campaigns, by sharing content messaging across stakeholder channels.

Website

During the election period, the website recorded 608,948 page views, attracting 158,462 active users and generating over two million engagements. Over 102,000 views on election day demonstrates the critical role of the website as a primary source of election information.

Election results and voting processes were the dominant focus for users with the most visited page being the new *provisional results* page with 152,370 views followed closely by *the final results* page with 116,087 views and the *2025 Local Government Elections* page with 78,836 views.

Pages related to postal votes received, enrolment, and did not vote collectively accounted for over 36,000 views, highlighting interest in voting compliance and participation details.

Election results



Optional preferential voting

The elections were conducted under the system of Optional Preferential Voting, which was introduced following a legislation change for the 2023 Local Government Ordinary Elections. This is the same system used for State and Federal elections.

Under this system, electors number candidates in the order of their preference. Electors do not have to number all the boxes, meaning there are many ways that electors can list, or choose not to list, their preferences according to their intention. To cast a formal vote, electors must place at least the number 1 in the square opposite the name of the candidate they want as their first preference.

For a candidate to be elected, they must receive enough votes to reach a quota. A quota is the targeted number of votes used to determine the election outcome through a formula:

$$\text{Quota} = ((\text{Number of formal votes}) / (\text{Number of vacancies} + 1)) + 1$$

Additional resources (including a training video) were developed to support Returning Officers in the conduct of both manual and full data entry counts of the ballot papers.

Results

Provisional results

Following the close of polls at 6:00pm on Saturday, 18 October 2025, counting commenced at Local Government offices and the WAEC central Processing Centre.

For the first time, the WAEC website published provisional results prior to the formal declaration of each election outcome. This initiative provided external stakeholders with an early indication of election trends and outcomes.

Final results

All Local Government election results administered by the WAEC were officially declared by Tuesday 21 October 2025, and published on the WAEC website three days after Election Day.

Of the 167 elections conducted through to polling:

- 54 results were declared on 18 October
- 86 results on 19 October
- 23 results on 20 October
- 4 results on 21 October

In accordance with Regulation 81 of the *Local Government (Elections) Regulations 1997*, a report of the election results was submitted to the Minister for Local Government on 30 October 2025. Additionally, each Local Government received a Calculated Steps Report, detailing the distribution of voting preferences specific to their elections. The Calculated Steps Report provides information about the preference allocation process.

Sitting members

Out of a total of 515 vacancies, 502 were filled, with 223 (44.4 percent) sitting members re-elected and 279 (55.6 percent) non-sitting members elected.

Mail

Late mail

Some electors did not return their completed postal ballot packages in time for inclusion in the count.

A total of 7,202 packages were received after the cut-off date of five business days following election day, representing 0.41 percent of all packages sent.

To minimise late returns, the WAEC arranged a special delivery through Australia Post on the morning of election day, and included reminders in election packages, communications, advertising and media releases. Electors also had the option of returning their completed package by hand to their Local Government polling place(s) by 6.00pm on election day.

Unclaimed mail

From the 1,736,004 postal voting packages issued, 35,958 were returned unclaimed (2.1 percent), which is the same as the 2.1 percent unclaimed rate recorded in 2023.

Invalidity complaints

During the 2025 Local Government Ordinary Election period, four invalidity complaints were received regarding the Shire of Gingin, Shire of Derby-West Kimberley, Shire of Menzies and City of Fremantle.

These complaints are matters for the Court of Disputed Returns.

Referendums

The Commission did not conduct any referendums in conjunction with the 2025 Local Government elections.



Stakeholder survey results

These are held after the election to capture feedback from Local Government CEOs, ROs and TEW. Key findings the post election survey results showed:

- CEOs Local Government (total responded 52 from 128): 84 percent of the respondents were satisfied or highly satisfied with the weekly updates, confirming that this approach helps to address common concerns.
- ROs (54 responses from 127): 78 percent rated their overall experience above average, citing improved confidence and responsiveness of WAEC support. 80 percent agreed that the information provided in the lead-up to the election was effective and ensured they had what they needed to perform their role. Feedback also identified opportunities for refinement, including resourcing, updating training content and strengthening early engagement with Local Governments.
- TEW (survey conducted by the service provider): 73 percent of staff working at the Processing Centre felt training was sufficient, suggesting additional software training, with 97.6 percent indicating they would consider working in this role again in the future.
