



# Notice of appointment of an agent by a Member of Parliament

*Electoral Act 1907, sections 175CA, 175E and 175K*

This form is to be used by a Member of Parliament to appoint a person as their agent.

Where no appointment is in place:

- If the member is a member of a registered political party, the party agent is the members agent
- If no appointment is in effect, then the member personally assumes the responsibility of the agent.

If a member appointed an agent while they were a candidate in an election, the appointment will remain in effect until it is revoked.

The appointment remains effective until written notice is received by Commission (WAEC) in accordance with sections 175K of the Act of the agent's death, resignation or revocation of their appointment.
