



State campaign account details

Electoral Act 1907, section 175LN

This form is to notify the Western Australian Electoral Commission of the State campaign account to be kept and maintained by a political entity. This form must be completed by the responsible person for a political entity.

A single form can be submitted by the responsible person for more than one Member of Parliament and / or candidate that are using the same State campaign account. These political entities can be listed in Part F.

Timeframe for notification

The Commission must be notified of a political entity's State campaign account, or of any changes to an existing State campaign account, within **five business days** of when the requirement to have State campaign account commences or when the change occurs. * If a candidate has not appointed a responsible person (agent), and is not endorsed by a registered political party, then they are their own agent.

If a group in a Council election has not appointed a responsible person (agent), and is not endorsed by a registered political party, then the first person whose name is to appear first in the group is the agent.
