



# Opt-in Request for Higher Reimbursement: Registered Political Party

*Electoral Act 1907, section 175LC*

A registered political party can use this form to opt into receiving the higher reimbursement amount for electoral funding in an election event. If a request is not received within the required timeframe for notification, the lower reimbursement amount will be used to calculate the maximum entitlement that the party can receive if eligible for electoral funding.

## Timeframe for notification

A registered political party must lodge their opt-in request with the Western Australian Electoral Commission within **28 days** after becoming a registered political party.

## Public information

The Western Australian Electoral Commission is required to publish the name of any registered political party that lodges a party opt-in request for the higher reimbursement amount within 5 days of receiving the request.

## Withdrawing a request

The party's registered officer can withdraw the request to receive the higher reimbursement amount by providing written notice to the Electoral Commissioner.
