**Post your vote early.** Completed postal voting packages must reach the Returning Officer by 6pm on election day, Thursday, 26 March 2026.

**You may hand deliver** your postal voting papers to an electoral officer, or **obtain a replacement package** (if the package is not received, or should any papers be missing), between 8am and 6pm **on election day** at the following location:
