### Types of Votes by District

The following table shows the types of votes recorded for all districts. Pilbara had the lowest number of votes (7,953) and Wanneroo recorded the highest number of votes (23,804). Voters used the ticket preference method when marking their ballot paper on approximately 96.07% of the total valid votes recorded.

## Legislative Council Types of Votes by Region – Metropolitan

The following tables show the types of votes recorded for the Legislative Council by metropolitan region and district.

The North Metropolitan Region recorded the greatest percentage of ordinary votes for a region with 78.02%. The East Metropolitan Region recorded the highest percentage of absent votes for a region with 10.16% and the highest percentage of postal votes with 5.34%. The North Metropolitan and South Metropolitan regions both issued the greatest percentage of early (in person) votes with 5.51% of the total votes. The East Metropolitan Region recorded the greatest percentage of informal votes with 3.26% of the total votes.

The district of Churclands recorded the highest percentage of ordinary votes in a district with 81.14% of the total votes. The Mount Lawley district recorded the highest percentage of absent votes with 12.64%, and the highest percentage of postal votes with 6.98% of total votes. The district of Rockingham recorded the highest percentage of early (in person) votes with 11.13%. The highest percentage of informal votes was recorded in the district of Balcatta with 4.48%.

The overall average number of votes recorded for the 42 metropolitan districts was 20,535.

The Agricultural Region recorded the greatest percentage of ordinary votes for a region with 77.57%, and the highest percentage of absent votes for a region with 12.11%. The South West Region recorded the highest percentage of postal votes with 4.65%. The Mining and Pastoral Region had the highest percentage of early (in person) votes with 6.51% of the total votes.

The district of Kimberley recorded the highest percentage of ordinary votes in a district with 82.42% of the total votes. 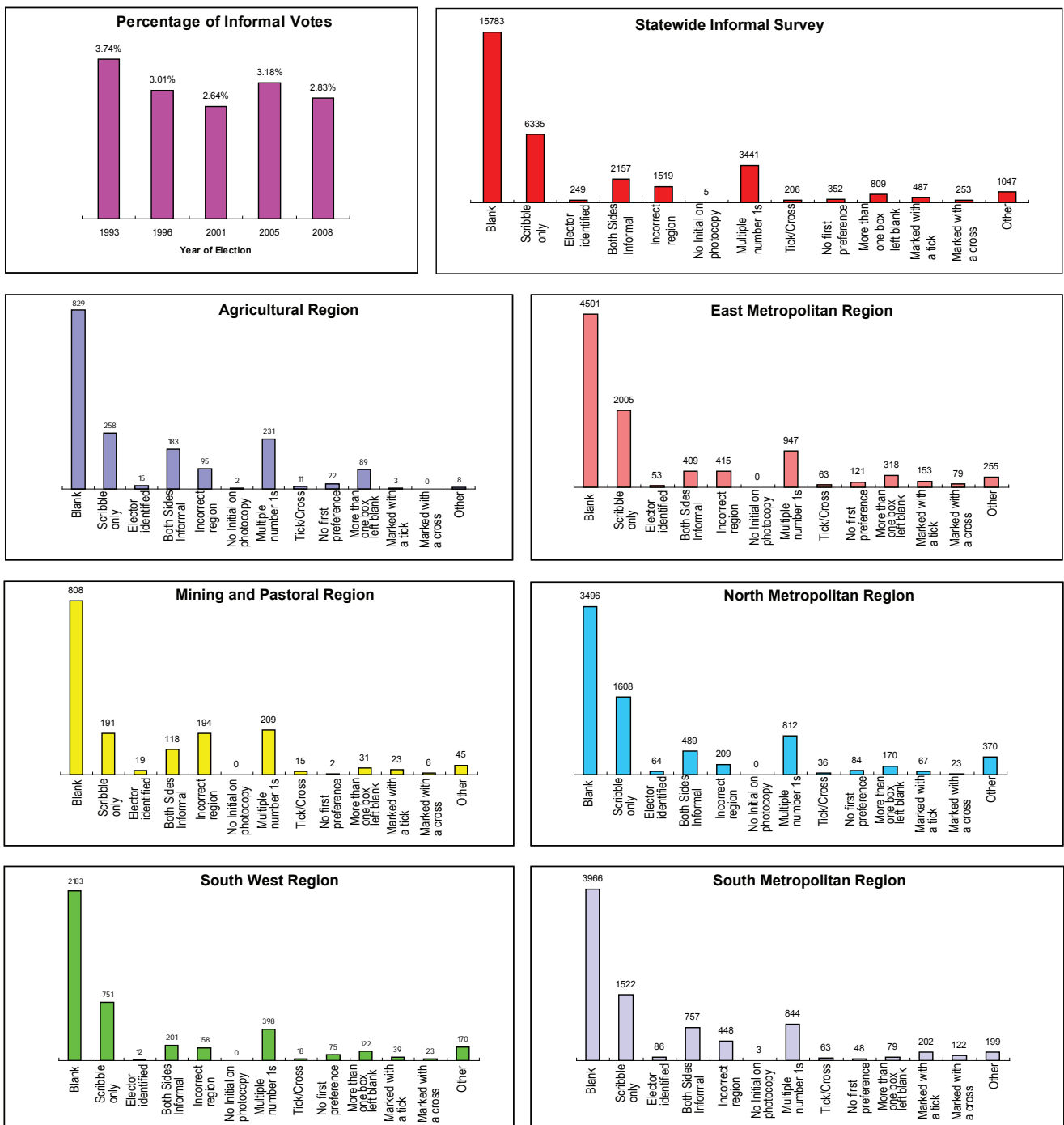
## Legislative Council Informal Voting Summary

### Informal Voting

Informal voting decreased in the Legislative Council from 3.18% to 2.83% in comparison with 2005 State General Election.

Ballot papers that are blank, do not show preferences in accordance with instructions and/or legislative requirements, or do not make the voter's intention clear are classified as informal. A ballot paper will also be informal if the voter can be identified through a marking on it. Informal ballot papers do not contribute to the election of a candidate and are not included in calculating the quota or absolute majority required for election.

Blank ballot papers constituted 48% of the informal vote, and ballot papers which were scribbled on comprised 19%.

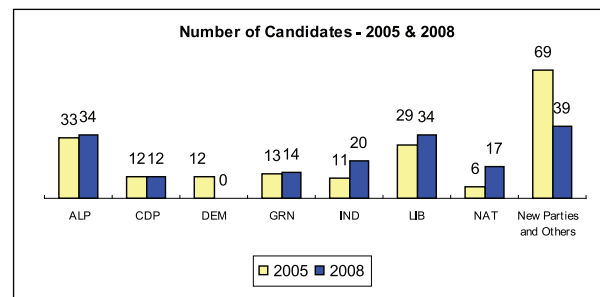
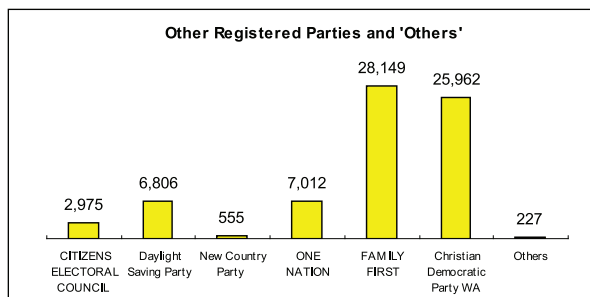
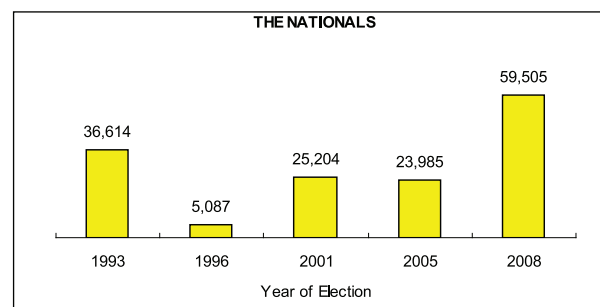
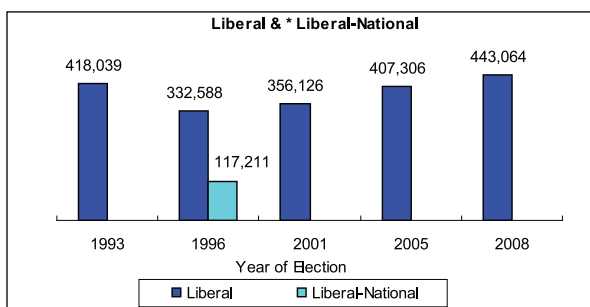
The balance of power in the Legislative Council has been strengthened as a result of the 2008 State general election.

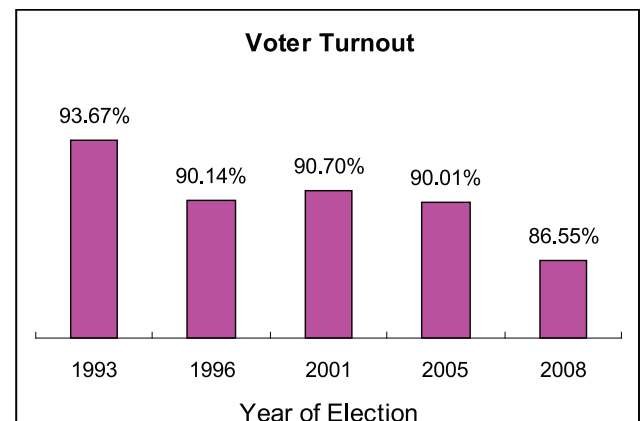
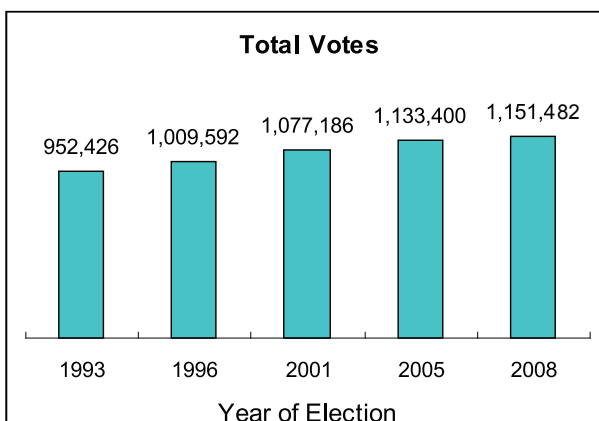
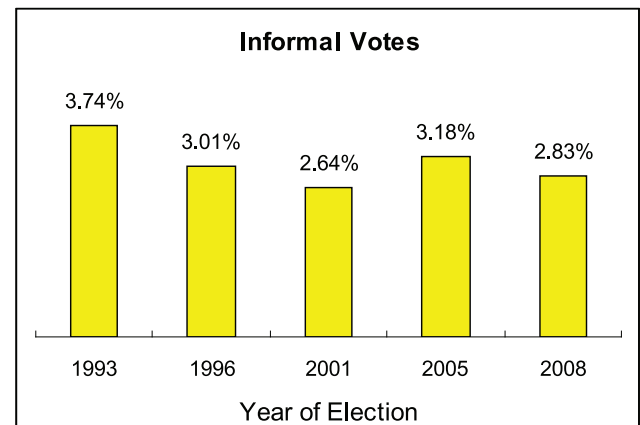
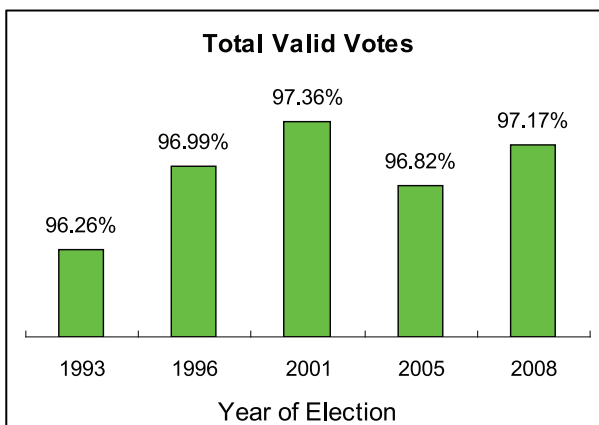
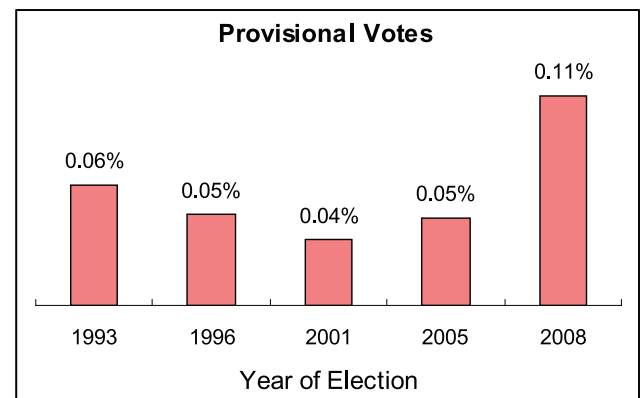
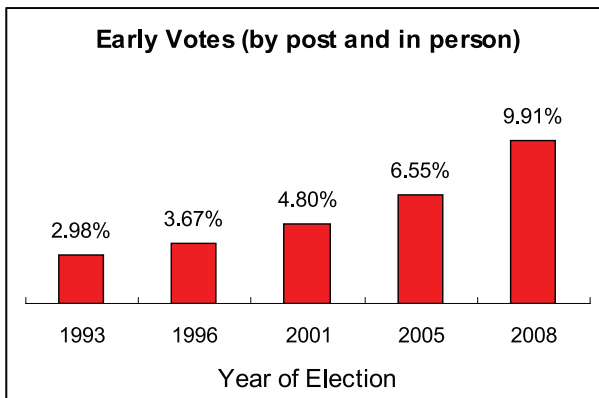
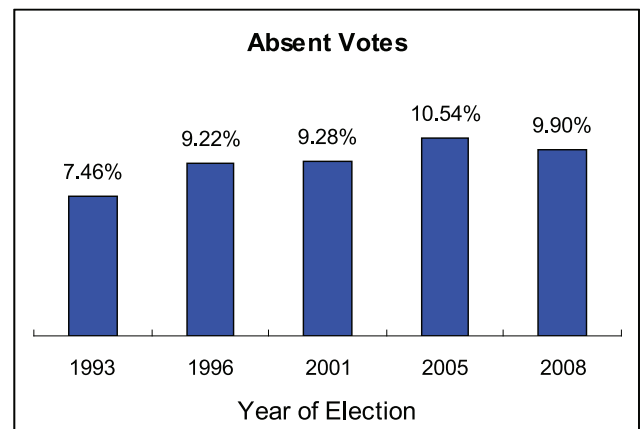
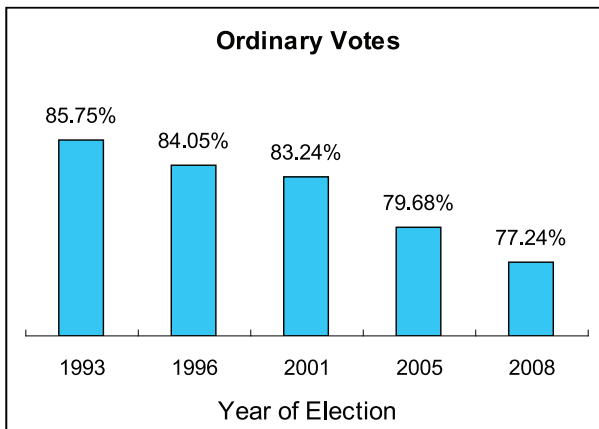
### Type of Votes Recorded
