Legislative Assembly Two-Candidate Preferred Result

The following table shows the two-candidate preferred result and the number and percentage of votes after the full distribution of preferences for the Legislative Assembly districts. The total votes shown exclude exhausted votes which were recorded during the distribution of preferences.

The district of Midland had the closest result with 24 votes separating the two candidates, requiring a swing of 0.07% to change hands, whilst Wagin had the greatest margin with 10,233 votes separating the two candidates, requiring a swing of 26.92% to change hands.

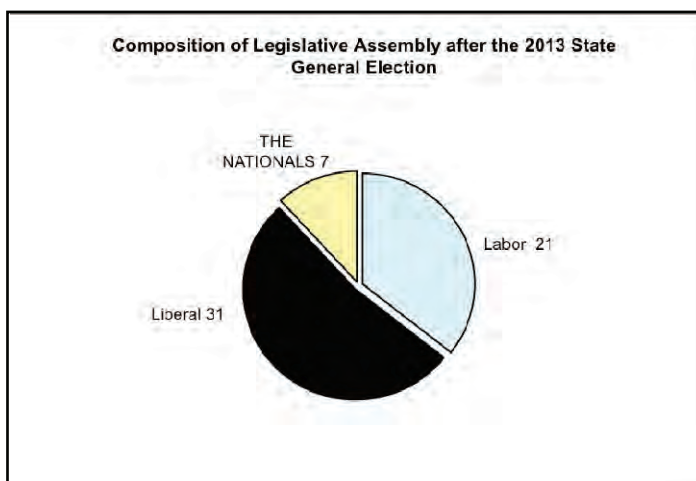
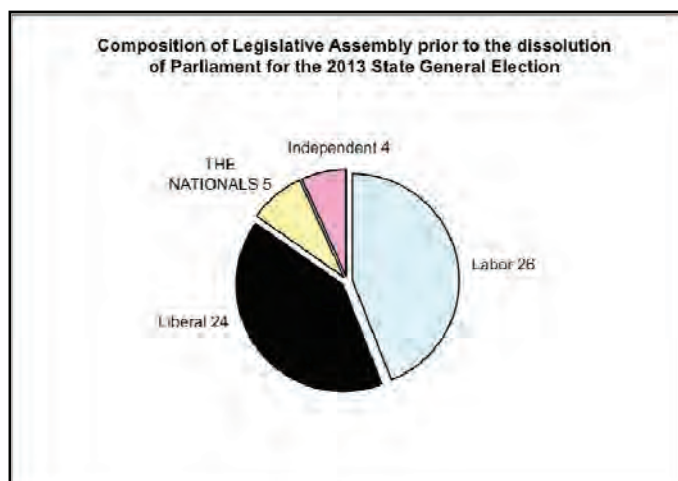

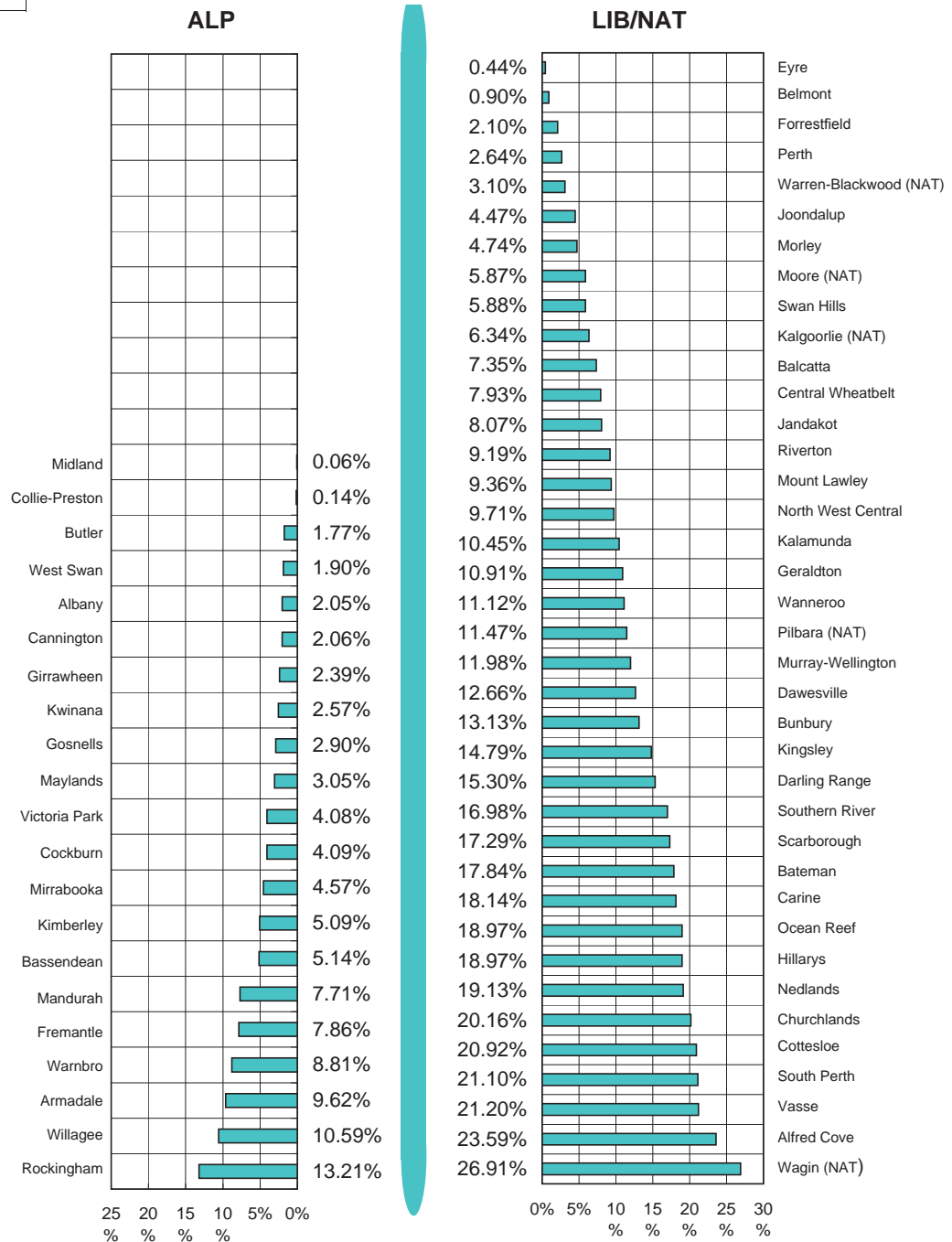
Balance of Power Prior to and After the 2013 State General Election

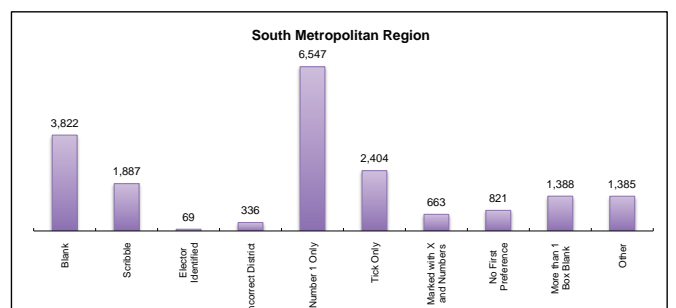
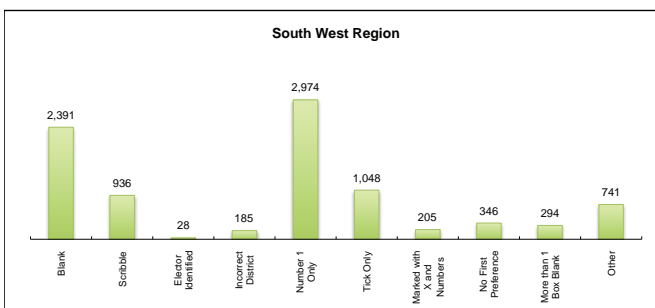
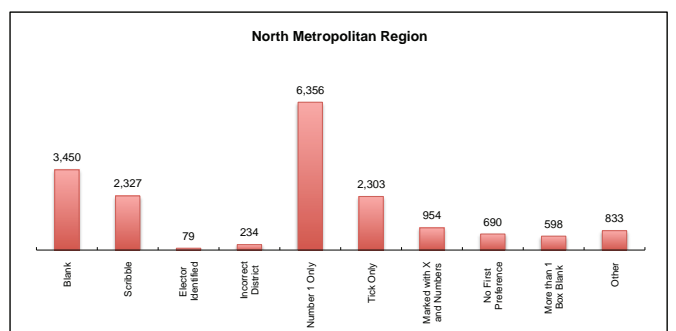
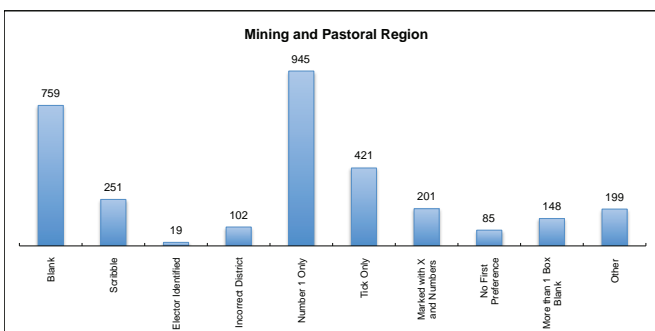
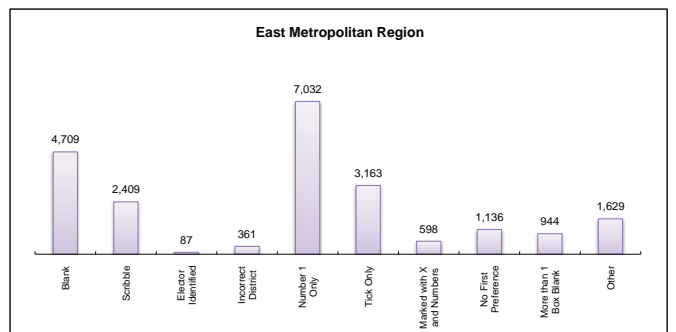
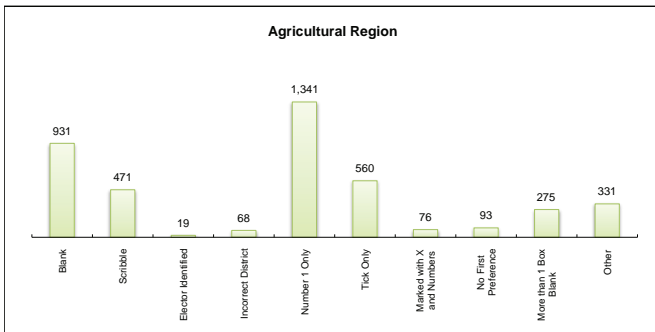
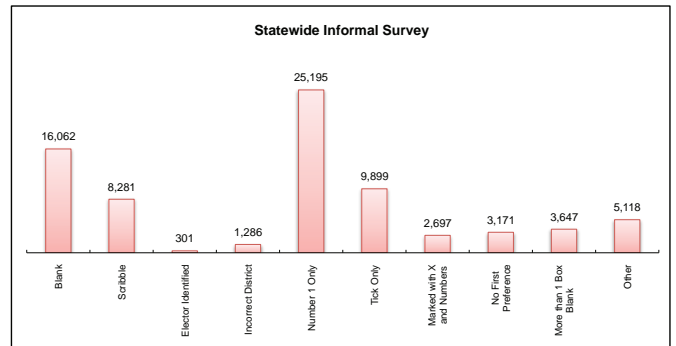
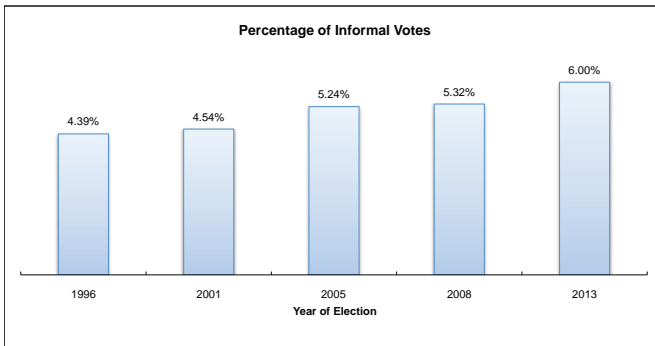
Legislative Assembly Informal Voting Summary

Informal Voting

The percentage of informal votes increased by 0.68% in the Legislative Assembly in this election.

Ballot papers which are blank, do not show preferences in accordance with instructions and/or legislative requirements, or do not make the voter's intention clear are classified as informal. A ballot paper will also be informal if the voter can be identified through a marking on it. Informal ballot papers do not contribute to the election of a candidate and are not included in calculating the quota or absolute majority required for election.

Blank ballot papers comprise 21.23% of all informal ballot papers. A further 10.95% of ballot papers were scribbled on and 13.08% of ballot papers contained only a tick mark. The largest group of informal votes, those marked with only a first preference, comprised of 33.30% of all informal ballot papers.

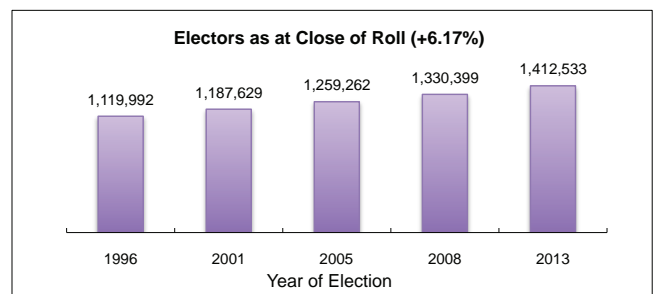
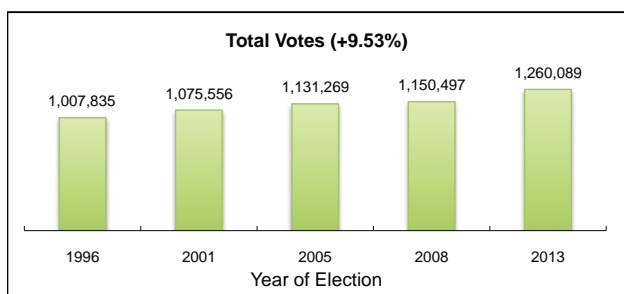
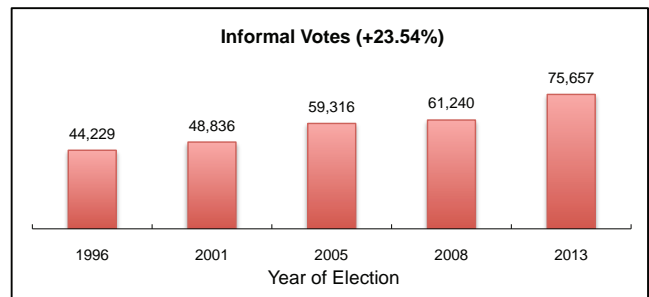
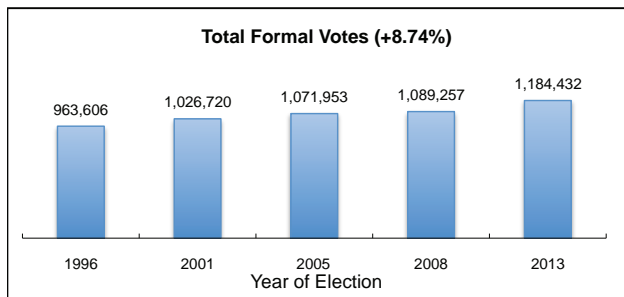
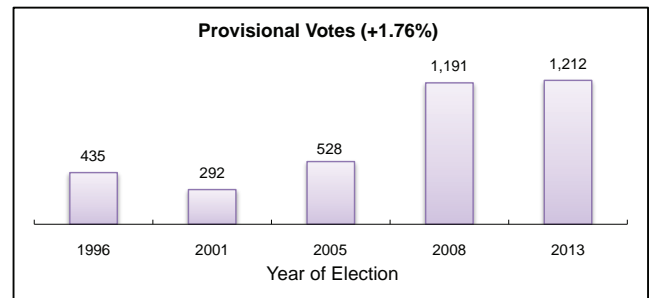
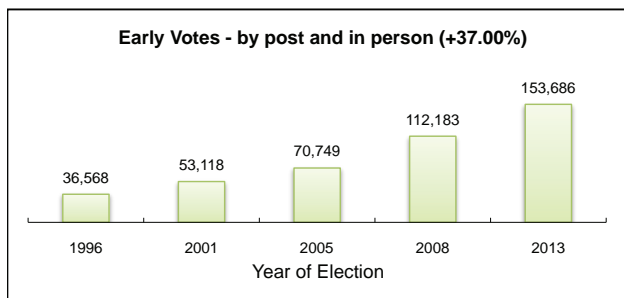
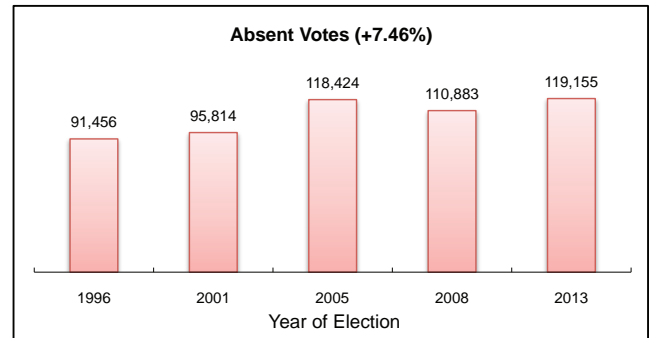
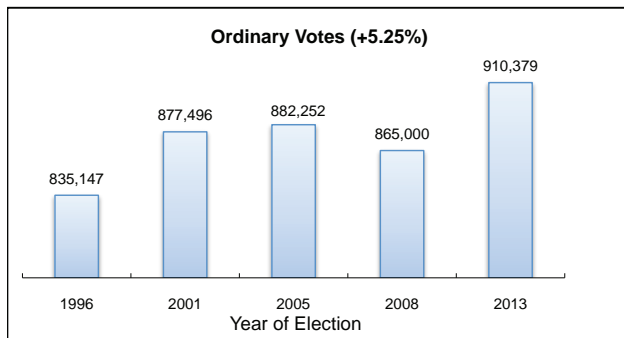
First Preference Votes

The Liberal Party recorded the highest increase in the number of first preference votes (139,695) compared with 2008. THE NATIONALS recorded the highest increase in percentage of first preference votes (35.05%) compared with 2008. The Greens (WA) recorded a substantial decrease in first preference votes (23.41%) compared with 2008. Australian Christians also recorded a substantial decrease in first preference votes (23.60%) compared with 2008. WA Labor recorded no discernible change to their first preference vote with a marginal increase (0.54%) compared with 2008. Family First recorded the greatest reduction in first preference votes (66.80%) compared with 2008.
