

## ELECTORAL ENROLMENT STATISTICS

30 June 2013

This report provides Western Australian electoral enrolment numbers for all electoral districts and regions as at 30 June 2013.

This report includes figures that illustrate the percentage change in total enrolment for each electoral district and region since 6 September 2010. Enrolment figures taken at 6 September 2010 were used to calculate the quotas on which the redistribution of State boundaries that will come into effect at the 2013 State General Election was based.

Large districts (100,000 km<sup>2</sup> or greater) qualify for a Large District Allowance (LDA) when electoral boundaries are drawn.

The LDA is calculated by multiplying the square kilometres of the district by 1.5%. The final number, calculated by adding the allowance to the number of electors in the district, must be within a range of 20% less or 10% greater than the average district enrolment.

The impact of the LDA on the variation from average district enrolment is shown in the Electoral District Quota report for the Mining and Pastoral Region
